

Ghana 2016

We are looking for a unit leader and an assistant unit leader.

What is it?

A community development project that will give the opportunity to participate in helping others abroad by building or teaching in Woe, Ghana. A group of 20 plus young people from Staffordshire will be going to Ghana from 25th March - 6th April 2016. They will learn about the culture and life of young people in Ghana and help by providing improved facilities within the community or supporting children, helping with lessons, reading stories and playing games with them.

The programme will include a Cape Coast adventure weekend

Flights will be from Birmingham Airport.

Accommodation will be in a volunteer house in Woe with one night in a hotel in Accra and on the Cape Coast.

Cost for leaders - up to £1,000

The visit is being organised through African Adventures who will have a representative locally for the whole of the project.
