What is it all about?

In July/August 2019, Staffordshire County Scouts are taking Scouts, Explorers, Network and Leaders to the Kandersteg International Scout Centre in Switzerland.

We will go for 12-14 days (between 28th July and 12th August), take part in various activities at the campsite and in the mountains around including walking, climbing, rafting, swimming in a mountain lake and going down a huge sled run! So, who can go?

Leaders who will be 18+ by 1st July 2019 and must hold a full leadership appointment (Beaver/Cub/Scout/Explorer Assistant Leader or Leader etc.) by 14th July 2019.

As a leader you need to be able to help with running of camps and also fundraising opportunities.

Is there a selection process?

This will depend on numbers. As a County, we would like to give as many leaders the opportunity to attend but we are limited on the number of people we can take.

Application forms need to be completed by 12.00 midday on 26th January 2018. You will then be contacted in the following few days if we need to have a selection day. If this is the case it will be the 3rd February 2018 at Beaudesert Campsite (so please keep this day free in your diary).

If you do get selected you will need to be available on the 9th-11th March for the Young Person selection weekend at Kibblestone Campsite if we need to select young people (depending on the number of young people who apply).

Once you have read through this information please continue the application on the next few pages, ensure all details are correct, and fill in as much information as possible.

How much will it cost?

At this point we are looking at a max cost of £1250 for young people but the adult cost would be less. This would cover all your flights, food, accommodation and activities. The cost of the adventure should not put off anyone from being part of this adventure, please contact Paul Creaser (Deputy County Commissioner) if this is a concern.

All Leaders are encouraged to fundraise to cover the cost of the trip, by doing so you will have the opportunity to learn new skills as well as contribute your own time towards the experience. As a leadership team, we will support as much as possible in fundraising.
